Advance Warning of Planned Footway Maintenance
Location: Bramley Road and Blechynden Street
From Silchester Road to Blechynden Street and from Bramley Road to End

Each year, the Council publishes a maintenance work programme for repaving the footpaths in the Royal Borough. The pavements on the list have been assessed by experienced highway inspectors who score each road based on a range of paving defects including broken paving stones, surface undulations, trips, and water ponding. This method of assessing the condition of pavements in the borough is used by many local authorities to plan their annual maintenance work.

I am writing to advise you that the above location is in this year's work programme. The Council's paving contractor FM Conway is due to start work relaying the footpath starting on 08/11/2023 and hope to finish within 5 weeks.

We will try to make sure that we cause you as little disruption and nuisance as possible, but there may be some noise while we break up the old surface. We will generally maintain access for residents throughout the work.

Can I take this opportunity to remind you to check for local parking restrictions while the contractor carries out the work. Those parking restrictions may include the Council suspending residents' parking spaces to allow the contractors clear access to the pavements.

I know that these vital repair works may seem an inconvenience while they take place, but I know you will appreciate the safe and long-lasting result once they are finished.
